



MONEY HUNT GAME MECHANICS

At the start of the game, your team will receive a booklet of clues pointing to twenty (20) different sites where money tokens have been hidden. You can travel at your own pace to reach the sites either on foot or on any mode of transport. Your group will need (1) one registered mobile phone (for communication to and from the event organiser throughout the event). In most cases, your group will need (1) one car (for transport around all the sites). However, in urban or suburban locations, public transport, bicycles or other non-motorised transport devices may also be used as appropriate. A group is allowed to use mobile phones, GPS devices, apps, maps or any other implements which may be used where it may be of an advantage to a group's strategy and success. When you succeed at discovering a site, you will find a set of the following three items: (1) A 3-digit combination lock (2) a money token keyring indicating the amount of money you have won and (3) a white screw-top cache with a code inside it. Immediately SMS the code to the event organiser and they will quickly respond with an SMS containing the 3-digit code you need to unlock the 3-digit combination lock. Take the set of combination lock, money token keyring and white screw-top cache with you to claim your money at the end of the game. You can win anything from \$5, \$10, \$20, \$50 or \$100 per site that you successfully discover ahead of everyone else. The more sites you discover first, the more money you win! You have a total of four hours to discover as many sites as you can before other groups do. You will receive a courtesy advise by SMS once a site has been found by another group, so you can direct your attention towards sites that have not yet been found. After 4 hours, all remaining undiscovered sites expire and participants must return to the designated meeting spot to claim prizes, return clue books and be accounted for by Money Hunt staff for safety reasons.

RULES & CONDITIONS

- Only registered individuals may participate in Money Hunt.
- Each competing group may consist of one (1) to four (4) participants.
- Participants must be at least twelve (12) years old to register. A child or children may only play as part of a group if accompanied by a parent, a guardian or a responsible adult eighteen (18) years or older to whom written parental authority has been granted.
- Remember that it is your responsibility to ensure that any vehicle or device that you use for the event are sufficiently covered by insurance in case of loss, damage, accident or the like.
- Each individual participant must be registered online at www.moneyhunt.com.au prior to the event. Please refer to the Money Hunt website for details on registering online.
- You will receive an electronic ticket by email once your registration is complete. Please print the e-ticket or save a copy to your mobile device for sighting on the actual day of the hunt.
- All Money Hunt sites are located in areas that are safe and accessible to pedestrians; either fixed to existing man-made infrastructures such as paths, staircases, beach access ramps, boardwalks, signs, handrails and the like. At no time will a Money Hunt site be located in areas that will require you to venture into pedestrian restricted areas or private property.
- At no time will Money Hunt sites be situated in areas that could foreseeably pose a threat to the safety of participants, to the local environment or to private property. Participants are expected to abide by local council, state and national park laws at all times.
- All vehicle driving, bicycle riding or pedestrian movement throughout a Money Hunt event is the responsibility of the group's nominated driver(s) and associated individuals in accordance with Victorian Law and road safety and pedestrian guidelines.
- At no time will a Money Hunt site be located in fragile ecological systems or animal habitat areas. At all stages of the event, please make every effort to stay to existing designated paths and areas free from wildlife habitats and leave any area you visit in the same way you found it.
- You participate at your own risk when playing for Money Hunt.
- You must not participate in a Money Hunt event if you have a pre-existing injury or medical condition that may be exacerbated by joining the event, or that may pose danger to yourself or to others.
- You must not participate in Money Hunt if you are under the influence of drug or alcohol.
- Should any medical emergency arise while out and about during this event, you must seek the assistance of Ambulance Victoria by dialling 000. Money Hunt organisers or any of your co-participants reserve the right to seek the assistance of Ambulance Victoria on your behalf, at your cost.
- Money Hunt reserves the right to cancel an event for health and safety considerations, including extreme weather disturbances, security threats, amongst others. Please refer to Booking Conditions on the Money Hunt website for details on refunds in case of cancellations.
- Photos or videos of yourself whilst participating in Money Hunt may be taken for the sole purpose of advertising or promotional content in our website, Facebook page, printed advertisements or any other marketing propaganda. You must inform Money Hunt if you do not consent to this.

In consideration for participating in Money Hunt, you understand that there are one or a combination of inherent risks involved in outdoor recreational games such as Money Hunt. These risks may include but are not limited to: 1) contact or collision with persons or objects (e.g., collision with spectators or course personnel), contact with other participants, contact or collision with motor vehicles or machinery, and contact with natural or man-made fixed objects or obstacles); 2) encounter with obstacles (eg. road and surface hazards); 3) equipment related hazards (e.g., broken, defective or inadequate competition equipment); 4) weather-related hazards (e.g., extreme heat, extreme cold, humidity, ice, rain, fog); 5) inadequate first aid and/or emergency measures; 6) judgment and/or behaviour-related problems (e.g., erratic or inappropriate co-participant or spectator behaviour, errors in judgment by personnel working the event; 7) natural hazards (e.g. uneven terrain, rock falls, lightning strikes, earthquakes, bushfire, wildlife attacks, contact with poisonous plants, marine life and/or ticks); 8) security related incidents (eg. terrorist attack). You understand that not all risks can be predicted and that you may face harm (including the risk of death or personal injury) by taking part in Money Hunt. You are aware that the game is self-guided and predominantly played without physical supervision from Money Hunt organisers. You are aware that participating in Money Hunt may involve some level of moderate to heavy physical exertion, and that it is your responsibility to ensure that your level of fitness is suitable to the level of physical exertion you assume. You understand that if you fail to provide relevant information about your health and capabilities, including any pre-existing or previous injuries or medical conditions that may either affect you or any participant's safety or that may be exacerbated by participation in the course and that if you fail to provide this information, the staff will not be able to take appropriate action to limit the risk of harm to yourself. You warrant that you will not participate in the activity whilst affected by drugs and alcohol, and that participation after the consumption of drugs or alcohol will remove any and all liability and responsibility from Money Hunt staff. You assume all risks outlined in this document (and other risks that may not be predicted) and agree to waive all liability claims against Money Hunt in relation to any form of injury or death you may suffer as a result. You will not sue Money Hunt, their employees or agents for any claims, costs, damages or liabilities you may have for injuries or loss suffered by you. You understand that this waiver represents a legal release and discharge of legal responsibility to Money Hunt, their employees or agents and is provided in consideration for participation in a Money Hunt event. If you participate in Money Hunt, your rights to sue the supplier under the Australian Consumer Law and Fair Trading Act 2012 if you are killed or injured because the activities were not supplied with due care and skill or were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this notice. The change to your rights, as set out in or on this notice, does not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the supplier's part. Gross negligence, in relation to an act or omission, means doing the act or omitting to do an act with reckless disregard, with or without consciousness, for the consequences of the act or omission. See regulation 5 of the Australian Consumer Law and Fair Trading Regulations 2012 and section 22(3)(b) of the Australian Consumer Law and Fair Trading Act 2012.
